ITINERARY IN DETAIL

DAY 1: HANOI ARRIVAL – CITY TOUR

Welcome to Hanoi! - the capital of Vietnam, is a bustling metropolis with a rich history and culture.

We will pick you up at Noi Bai Airport and transfer you to the city center. You will have free time to relax after long flight.

In the afternoon, we will visit **Ba Dinh Square**, the largest square in Hanoi. This is where all of the city's biggest cultural and political events take place. We will take some photos of the **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum** from the outside. Then we continue to the **Temple of Literature**, Vietnam's first university. The temple was built in 1070, and the gardens and well-preserved architecture offer a relaxing glimpse into Vietnam's past.

After visiting the temple, we will walk around **Hoan Kiem Lake**, a picturesque lake in the heart of Hanoi. The lake is home to a number of temples and pagodas, and it is a popular spot for locals and tourists alike. We will then take a leisurely walk around the **Old Quarter of Hanoi**, a fascinating network of narrow alleys and shophouses. The Old Quarter is also known as "**The 36 Streets**," as each street is named after the merchandise that was traditionally sold there. Overnight in Hanoi.



DAY 2: HANOI - NINH BINH - HOA LU - TAM COC - HANOI (B, L) – SIC TOUR

Have breakfast at hotel. At 07:30 – 08:00 am, you will be picked up at your hotel in **Hanoi Old Quarters**. Get on the bus for your journey to **Ninh Binh**, the ancient capital of Vietnam. The 90-kilometer drive south will take you through stunning countryside, where rice paddies stretch to the horizon and sometimes seeing water buffalo graze in the fields. In Ninh Binh, you'll visit **Hoa Lu**, the site of **the Dinh and Le temples**. These temples were built in the 10th century to honor the **Dinh and Le kings** of Vietnam. They are famous for their beautiful wooden carvings. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, you'll take a boat trip through **Tam Coc**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This stunning landscape is home to towering limestone karsts that rise up from the lush green rice paddies. It's been called the "**Halong Bay on Land**," and it's easy to see why. Leisure cycling on rural roads alongside the extensive canal network and through small villages with back drop of a maze of limestone mountains. After your boat trip, you'll drive back to Hanoi. Arrives at your hotel around 18:30-19:00. Overnight in Hanoi.

DAY 3: HANOI - HALONG BAY – OVERNIGHT ON CRUISE (B, L, D) – SHUTTLE BUS

Breakfast at the hotel, then check out. Approximately at 8:00am, you will be picked up at your hotel in **Hanoi Old Quarters** and transferred to **Ha Long Bay**, the pride of the **Gulf of Tonkin**, a **Natural World Heritage** as recognized by UNESCO in 1994 and 2006.

Upon arrival at **the Cruise Port**, you will enjoy a warm welcome from cruise staff and complete the check-in procedure for the overnight cruise to discover the magnificent beauty of this "**Descending Dragon**" bay, created by thousands of odd-shaped limestone rocks and karst grottoes. After a lunch on board, we can visit **the Grottos**, stop for swimming or kayaking, pass floating houses, and approach islets to enjoy their beauty in close proximity. Later in the afternoon, go back to the cruise and enjoy the **cooking demonstration** before having dinner. In the evening, attend activities on the boat or relax at your own leisure. Overnight on the cruise.



DAY 4: HALONG – HANOI (B/BR) – SHUTTLE BUS

You should wake up early to enjoy the dawn on the sea in the early morning. The Vietnamese call the "East Sea" by a point-oriented name "Eastern Sea", so you may guess how miraculous seeing the sunrise over the islets of the Bay. After breakfast our boat will continue to cruise in marvelous areas, where almost each islet has its own name, adopting its shape or reminiscent like **Sail Island, Fisherman's head rock, Butterfly rock or Turtle islet** etc. Check out your room and have brunch on board while the cruise coming back the pier. Disembark from the cruise, transfer back to Hanoi. Check in your hotel in **Hanoi Old Quarters**. Your time at leisure. Overnight in Hanoi.

DAY 5: HANOI DEPARTURE (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Time at leisure until check-out, and transfer to the airport with a driver only (**No guide escort**) for the departure flight back to your sweet home.

ITINERARY IN DETAIL

DAY 1: DA NANG ARRIVAL – HOI AN TOWN (NA)

Welcome to Vietnam! Upon your arrival at Danang Airport, you will be picked up (without guide) and transferred to Hoian. Hoian is a charming UNESCO World Heritage Site in central Vietnam that is known for its well-preserved ancient town, traditional crafts, and delicious food. Check-in the hotel. Rest time of the day at leisure. Overnight in Hoian.

DAY 2: HOI AN TOWN – CAM THANH COCONUT BASKET BOAT – HOI AN ANCIENT TOWN – HOI AN TOWN (B, D) – SIC TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel

Free at leisure in the morning.

About 12:50 PM : The van and tour guide will pick you up at your hotel (Hoi An area)



Start your adventure with **Cam Thanh Coconut** for being a fisherman at Cam Thanh Coconut Village, you will experience about learning traditional fishing techniques and how **to row unique Vietnamese bamboo basket boats** while exploring the tranquil coconut palm waterways of the past war. On this tour, we provide authentic social and cultural insight into the local way of life in Vietnam. Furthermore, you will take part in some hands-on activities which are fun, safe, and interesting and are suitable for everybody.

About 2.30 pm: Visit to the next destination to **Hoi An Old Town**.

- Go to the **Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall**, a colorful mélange of bright gates, dragon statues, and elaborate rooftops. Get an introduction to ancestor worship while visiting the family altar and watching local devotees making offerings.
- You will see remarkably well-preserved old houses, **Phung Hung Ancient House or Tan Ky Ancient House** that have withstood 200 years of weather and war. Learn about the prosperous

merchants who used to live in these homes, trading with buyers from all around the world. Visit **Museum of Folk Culture in Hoi An** A display of artifacts depicts ancient local daily life. Especially, you will enjoy art shows at **Hoi An Traditional Performing Arts House**.

- Make a stop at the **Japanese Bridge**. The bridge spans a small waterway and was constructed more than 400 years ago to connect the Japanese community with the Chinese who lived on the other side of the water. Admire the carvings and paintings inside the bridge, learning about their symbolism and cultural significance.
- Additionally, visit some of Hoi An's well-known handicraft shops and artwork galleries. Discover smaller laneways and local neighborhoods, gaining a better appreciation of Hoi An's endless charm.
- **Dinner with Hoi An specialty food.**
- **6.00 pm:** Enjoy your time with the **boat ride on Hoai River** and release the flower lanterns to pray for the best of luck to you and your family. You will immerse yourself in the fanciful space of the lantern street. Free your time with the night market and enjoy the shimmering space of Hoi An.
- **6.30 pm – 7.00pm:** Return to your hotel. **End of our services!**

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DAY 3: HOI AN – DA NANG MORNING CITY TOUR – DA NANG (B, L) – SIC TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel

7:30 – 8:00 am We'll pick you up at the hotel and transfer you to Da Nang city (around 30km).

8:30 am Our van will transfer you to **Monkey Mountain**. A giant statue of **Lady Buddha** with a beautiful background such as mountains and a huge garden of bonsai would draw your attention. You will definitely get lost in the garden of heaven with gripping stories when gently walking and enjoying a fresh breeze.

9:30 - 10:00 am:

- Discovery the **Marble Mountains** and stop for a walk along the site to see local factories of **stone sculptures** - the most impressive handicrafts village in Da Nang.

- Check in the Marble Mountains by climbing up to the top (**elevator is not included**). Here we will see beautiful pagodas which were made in the 19th century by the last dynasty of the Vietnam monarchy, and visit **Huyền Không or Tàng Chơn Caves**.

- Keep going to see the biggest fascinating cave named as **Âm Phủ Cave**. You will learn interesting philosophies of Buddhism and take photos with amazing natural creations.

11:45 am Have lunch at a local restaurant with local and authentic Vietnamese cuisines.

1:00 pm Tour finishes, our private car will pick you up and transfer to hotel in Da Nang city

DAY 4: DA NANG – BA NA HILLS DAY TRIP – GOLDEN BRIDGE – DA NANG (B, L) – SIC TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel 7h40-8h15am: Pick visitors up from your location (hotel or the city center) and join to our group to visit Sun World Bana Hills (Sun World Ba Na Hills is endowed with all climate and natural advantages for a tourist area) with the height of 1487 meters above the sea level. Here, visitors are immersed in experiences of European cultural tranquility and exciting stops where festivities know no ends). This is the French high-quality resort in 1990s.

9h00-9h30am: The bus arrives to Bana Hills entrance, starting the journey up the mountain by cable car, achieving 2 world records - the longest in the world at 5,042.62m - the height difference between the two largest stations in the world at 1,291.81m. Visitors will stop at 3rd cable car station and visit around some points such as: Golden Bridge (golden hand bridge), 100 year-old Debay wine cellar, Love Garden - Le jardin d'amour, 1st Main Road pagoda with a Giant Lady Buddha



statue with 27m height. 11h30- 12h00am: Visitors have lunch inside a buffet restaurant on the top of Bana Hills. You got free time to explore games in Fantasy Park, the largest indoor recreational area of Vietnam that spares hundreds of indoor games for families and children.

3h00-3h30pm: Visitors gather at the meeting points, checking belongings and enter the cable car to leave Bana hills.

3h30-4h00pm: The group return to Danang city, and visit the local Silk craft village and local specialties foods on the way back.

5h00-5h30 pm: The bus will drop you at the same point picking up in the morning – finish the tour. Overnight in Danang

DAY 5: DA NANG DEPARTURE (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Time at leisure until check-out, and transfer to the airport with a driver only (**no guide**) for the departure flight back to your sweet home.
